ADVANCED CERTIFICATES

Level 6 awards (Advanced Certificates) provide enhanced progression into year two of higher education programmes where the higher programme is in a similar discipline. This mechanism is known as ‘advanced entry’. In some cases, a candidate with a level 6 award may be offered exemptions from elements of programmes within the first year. This is at the discretion of the higher education institution.

In addition, you will gain a strong foundation in cyber security. National Commis Chef

The National Commis Chef Apprenticeship Programme is the starting point for a career as a professional chef. It follows the Earn & Learn model, blending off the job knowledge and skills development in a ETB Training Centre and on the job practical skills development with the apprentice's employer, within a formal, structured two year programme. Upon successful completion, the newly qualified Commis Chef will receive a QQI Level 6 Major Award - Advanced Certificate in Culinary Arts.

Bar Manager

The aim of the programme is to develop compliant, confident and effective bar managers who can work autonomously, manage all aspects of a bar trade while delivering an excellent consistent customer and staff experience.

The programme also aims to provide a progression route to other third level programmes for example: BA (Hons) in Hospitality Management.

The learner will gain a range of integrated skills required to operate a compliant bar trade including the legal and regulatory framework, leadership and management, food and beverage, commercial skills, finance, marketing, human resource management, communications, and personal development.

Graduates will be able to take senior positions as bar managers nationally and internationally in the licensed trade, hotels and other food and beverage retail outlets.



Adult Guidance Service
